Esther 9:28-32 The observance of Purim.

Esther 9:27 ...the Jews established and firmly accepted on themselves and on their descendants, and on anyone who might convert to Judaism, to faithfully observe these two days, as written, and at the right times, each and every year. -From BeingJewish.com

Esther 9:27 ...the Jews firmly obligated themselves and their offspring and all who joined them, that without fail they would keep these two days according to what was written and at the time appointed every year. -From the English Standard Version

Esther 9:27 ...the Jews took it upon themselves to establish the custom that they and their descendants and all who join them should without fail observe these two days every year, in the way prescribed and at the time appointed. -From the New International Version
