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Torah Reading Noah 2009: The Flood and Living Water

Genesis 6:9 Noah: A righteous man in an exceedingly corrupt generation. In these days before Messiah's return, how closely do we walk with God?

Genesis 6:13 The end of all flesh has come before God.

Isaiah 30:33 Hell.

Matthew 24:37-39 Noah's generation is like the generation who will witness Messiah's return.

Revelation 20:11-15 The judgment.

Genesis 6:18 God establishes a covenant with Noah as the last righteous man on Earth, before God wipes out mankind.

Isaiah 28:14-15 Is this the sort of "covenant" the rest of the world thought they made?

Jeremiah 31:30-33 (31-34) A new covenant.

Ezekiel 36:25-27 A heart of flesh.

Genesis 8:1 The Spirit (wind. Heb: *ruach*) and the water.

Genesis 1:2 The Divine Presence hovering over the water. Same spirit? Yeshua?

Veha'arets hayetah tohu vavohu vechoshech al-peney tehom veruach Elohim merachefet al-peney hamayim

Psalms 29:3 The voice of God is upon the waters. Who is "the voice"?

The water receding is what saves what's left of mankind. Is this Yeshua's role, even then?

Genesis 8:17 Be fruitful and multiply. Repopulating the Earth.

Genesis 1:28 Populating the Earth.

Genesis 8:21 God lifts his curse upon the ground.

Genesis 3:17-18 God's curse upon the ground.

If the curse is lifted, how come we still have weeds?

Genesis 9:3-4 Why does God give man permission to eat meat? Are the kosher laws currently in force?

Genesis 8:20 If Noah sacrificed every clean animal to God, what happened to the meat?

Leviticus 11:1-3 The kosher food laws.

Genesis 9:8-17 God's covenant with Noah and his offspring (everyone else) never to destroy the Earth by flood.

Is this the covenant mentioned in **Genesis 6:18**?

Isaiah 54:9-10 Is God's promise to never rebuke the Jewish people again just as permanent and absolute as his promise never to flood the Earth again?

Psalms 29:10 According to the Sages, in Messianic times, God's reign will be recognized by mankind as absolute, as it was in the flood when all mankind died.

Matthew 3:5-6 Is there any symbolism between the flood and how we immerse ourselves (mikvah) to die to sin and live to Yeshua?

Matthew 3:7-8 Is there any symbolism between John's words about the coming punishment and what will happen to those who disobey God? Can immersion be "going through the motions?"

Matthew 3:16 The dove and the water.

Genesis 8:8-12 The dove and the water.
