Numbers 13:27-29 The benefits of the Land and the promises of God weren't enough to overcome fear.

Numbers 13:30 Why did only Caleb have the courage to go against "the crowd" and stand up with God?

Numbers 14:6-9 Joshua and Caleb implore the people to keep up their faith in God.

Numbers 14:1-4 The fear of the ten spies spread like wildfire and slavery was preferable to war. Why didn't Caleb's courage spread among the people instead?

Proverbs 14:15 Righteous and foolish.

Ecclesiastics 10:1 Dead flies.

1 Corinthians 5:6-8 A little leaven.

Numbers 15:32-36 The man who gave up hope in God.

Numbers 14:36-38 Immediate consequences.

Numbers 14:40-45 Sometimes, if you don't answer God's call right away, it's too late to make it up later.
